Adoption of the Agenda

New Business

Deputy Clerk, Kerr gave a recap and updates on the Comp Plan revisions. In 2023, the Village had 6 new single-family constructions with 2 already moved in. Gas Station continues to get their permits. The Village is in the process of resourcing an early warning weather siren system to be located near the Village Hall.

The Committee reviewed Campton Hills' current border and highlighted areas where the Campton Hills and Lily Lake borders were close. The Committee recommends keeping the boundary lines close to their existing borders, and where the boundary crosses over Burlington Road, Campton Hills should stay north of the road and continue along west towards Burlington Road. The Committee agreed to using the Elburn and Lily Lake boundary agreement as a template and change wording accordingly. They also advised that it should reflect Campton Hills will not encroach their existing boundary. The Committee wants to keep much of the surrounding farm lands as land to be farmed.

Old Business

Commissioner Bork wanted to clarify the desire in having the Lake back into Lily Lake's boundary as open space for the public to enjoy. This should be reflected in the updated Comp Plan.
