**NOTICE OF PUBLIC ZONING HEARING**

The Village of Lily Lake is considering an amendment to its zoning ordinance that would permit keeping domestic livestock such as full and miniature horses and donkeys, miniature cows, mules, alpacas, llamas, ducks, geese, guinea hens, sheep, goats, and other similar domestic livestock animals on properties of at least four acres that are within the E1, E2, and R1 residential districts.

A public hearing will be held on the proposed amendments on Monday, June 24, 2024 at 5:30 p.m. in the Village Hall, 43W955 Twilight Lane, Lily Lake, IL 60175. All persons who are interested are invited to attend the public hearing. Anyone wishing to be heard for or against the amendment may submit a statement orally or in writing, or both. Copies of the proposed amendment are on file and are available for inspection during normal business hours at the Village office at the above address.
