Domestic Livestock Registration Procedure **Ordinance 2024-06**

1. Submit Building Application (*if applicable*)
2. Submit registration form
3. Pay required fees (\$25.00 one-time)
4. Attach two (2) copies of the plat of survey showing the location of the coop and outside fenced area, setbacks to property lines, setbacks to any adjacent occupied residential structures. Survey shall be to scale, not reduced or enlarged when copied.
5. Call J.U.L.I.E (Joint Underground Location for Inspectors and Engineers) at least 48 hours prior to any digging to locate any underground utilities. (Dial 811 or 800-892-0123) *if applicable*.
6. If property is not owner occupied, property owner's signature will be required on the building application and coop registration form.
7. Schedule the required inspections with the Village of Lily Lake *at least 48 hours* in advance to ensure that we can meet your schedule.

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PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS REGARDING THE KEEPING OF DOMESTIC LIVESTOCK

- All persons keeping domestic livestock in the Village of Lily Lake on residential single-family zoned parcels shall have a minimum of 4 acres and keep no more than 1 animal per full acre.
- Roosters shall not be kept anywhere on premise.
- Slaughter of any livestock shall not be allowed except for humane reasons only.
- The permitted domestic livestock shall include full and miniature horses, full and miniature donkeys, miniature cows (under 48" and less than 800 lbs), mules, alpacas, llamas, potbelly pigs, sheep, and goats.
- All livestock will be kept in suitable enclosures with access to enclosed structures protected from predators and the elements.
- All enclosures and covered structures will remain 30 feet from any lot line and 100 feet from any residence, other than the owner, but not less than the minimum property line setback required for accessory structures in the Zoning District.
- Electric service to enclosure will not be provided by electrical cord or extension cords.
- All enclosures and areas will be kept clean, sanitary, and free from rodents, odors, and contaminated drainage onto any other property at all times.
- Owner will ensure that the livestock will not produce unreasonable noise as described in Ordinance 2024-06.
- Owner agrees to allow Village staff personnel to access the yard of the residence for the purpose of verifying compliance with Ordinance 2024-06.
- Owners of domestic livestock on residential-zoned property must register with the Village prior to their acquisition and pay a one-time registration fee of \$25
- If it has been found that violations exist, fines and conditions apply. Refer to Ordinance 2024-06 for details.
