These updated candidate circulation and filing dates apply to those offices that do not require a primary:

August 20, 2024: First day to circulate petitions for consolidated election

November 12, 2024: First day to file nomination papers for consolidated election

November 18, 2024: Last day to file nomination papers for consolidated election

November 25, 2024: Last day to file objections to nomination papers for consolidated election

January 13, 2025: Last day for governing board to adopt a resolution allowing a binding/advisory question on the consolidated election ballot

January 23, 2025: Ballot certification deadline for consolidated election

April 1, 2025: Consolidated Election

The Village of Lily Lake will be accepting nomination papers from candidates for municipal office beginning November 12, 2024 through November 18, 2024. The Village is located at 43W955 Twilight Lane, St. Charles, IL 60175. There are (3) 4-yr term Trustee positions open for the April 1, 2025 Consolidated elections.

Petition filing hours will be during regularly posted office hours with extended office hours on Monday, November 18, 2024.

Regular Hours: M-TH, 9:00 am - 1:00 pm

November 18, 2024 hours: 9:00 am - 1:00 pm (closed 1:00-4:00) 4:00 pm - 5:00 pm

Village Clerk will not notarize filings for village positions to avoid an appearance of impropriety.

All documentation must be filled out correctly – consult the State of Illinois 2025 Candidate’s Guide, the State Elections Board (see below for contact info) or legal counsel.

Ballot position is determined as follows:

1. All petitions filed by persons waiting in line the first day of filing before the office opens will be deemed filed simultaneously.
2. Petitions filed by mail and received at opening in the office of the first day of filing will be deemed filed simultaneously.
3. Ballot position for subsequent filings is determined by time and date.
4. A lottery drawing approved by the State Board of Elections will be held for simultaneous filings to break any ties.
5. Persons seeking assistance with filing of documents at the open of business on the first day of filing will NOT be considered to have filed at opening time for the purpose of a lottery draw for ballot position.

01/23/2025 Ballot Certification by 4:00 pm (*may be certified and submitted earlier if no objections are considered*)
